**NOTICE**

With the approval of CA, the following guidelines are to be followed by students/scholars who are planning to come to NIT Manipur campus to carry out their laboratory oriented research works.

- A. In compliance with MHA order 40-3/2020-DM-I(A), clause no 1(ii) Ph.D. and post graduate student requiring Laboratory / Experimental works will be permitted to campus from 15<sup>th</sup> October 2020. However, day scholars may visit laboratories with consent of their Supervisor/Guides and Laboratory Incharges.
- B. The guidelines for those Ph.D. and post graduate students should follow the following guidelines.

**Guidelines for Students/Scholars who want to return to NIT Langgol Campus**

1. Students/Scholars should apply to respective wardens citing requirement(s) to return to hostels.
2. Their applications should be accompanied by **consent letter of their parents** and duly **forwarded by their respective Guide/Supervisor(s)**.
3. While coming to hostels, students/scholars should submit photo copy of RAT result to their respective wardens.
4. Students/Scholars will be admitted to hostels only if their RAT result is negative.
5. They should avoid gathering and visiting social places for a period of 14 days, which will be regarded as quarantine period.
6. Within quarantine period, if any health issues arise, students/scholars should immediately inform their respectively guide/supervisor(s).
7. Students/Scholars should follow SOP published by Government of India or Government of Manipur from time to time.
8. There will be no common mess facility; as such it is the responsibility of the students/scholars to make arrangement for food.
9. Rooms, common areas, and surroundings should be kept clean and hygienic by M.Tech/PhD students.
10. If any student violates any rule during roll call extension and exposes to harmful way, it will be the sole responsibility of the student of his / her safety.
