ITEM NO. 23.4: Fencing of OBC Girl's Hostel

Decision taken: Fencing of the OBC Girl's Hostel located at Langol campus funded by Ministry of Social Justice and Empowerment is recommended by the committee considering that all first-year B.Tech Girls students who are presently residing in Takyel Campus and in Barrack, Langol campus and the PG students residing in Director's Bungalow will be shifted to the OBC Girl's Hostel. The tentative estimated cost of the fencing by GI Profile Sheets is approximately Rs.8,93,582/-. The abstract of cost and the relevant drawing is also placed as Annexure 23.1. The committee recommends that the cost of fencing to be incurred from IRG and further ratified in the upcoming FC and BOG.

ITEM NO. 23.5: Status on Revised DPR (Timeline of Communication)

Decision taken: Committee was informed on the present status of the Revised DPR. The timeline of communication as on 25/07/2023 was noted by the committee.

ITEM NO. 23.7: Proposal and Reporting on dumping of excavated earth to NIT Campus

Decision taken: In view of the frequent flooding problem in NIT campus, the suggestion made by the Water Resources Department, Govt. of Manipur for dumping of the excavated earth from Lamphelpat area to the selected (eastern and western side of NIT campus) site of NIT campus is discussed. It is recommended by the committee that the proposal/suggested activity (i.e., dumping of excavated earth to NIT campus) may be allowed if no extra cost for the activity is borne by the NIT Manipur. Committee also observed that such activity will be beneficial by both the parties (i.e., excavation of earth to accommodate the excess water in Lamphelpat which is around the NIT campus and dumping of these excavated earth to low lying areas of NIT campus).

The Meeting ended with a vote of thanks by Registrar, Member Secretary of the Building & Works Committee.
