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The Senate discussed all the following items in detail and resolved them as noted below:

To give approval to start M.Tech in ME (Mechanical Engineering) with intake of 15 V. students from 2016.

To recommend the advertisement of remaining unfilled seats in M.Tech for Non-VI. GATE candidates with minimum cut-off marks in the written test.

To recommend the amendment of M.Tech ordinance for CE Department to include VII. MSc in relevant subjects as eligibility criteria (Annexure III, pp 12).
