	b) Re-sectioning and/or Clearance of Minor Drains in NIT Manipur Campus, with Vertical Sluice Gates (local-made) to control/regulate back water
	flood flows to the drainage network system inside the campus.
	c) Provisioning of Rain-water gutters pipes on the roof of the Academic building and conveyance for containing the uncontained flow and to mitigate perpetual waterlogging, whilst also serving as a rain water
	harvesting unit.
