Item No. 19.1 Confirmation of the Minutes of the 18<sup>th</sup> Building & Works Committee held on 16<sup>th</sup> November

Decision taken: Minutes of the 18<sup>th</sup> BWC was circulated to all members and as no comment was received in this regard, the minute was considered to be confirmed and accordingly, the house passed the same.

Item No. 19.2 Action taken on the decision of the 18<sup>th</sup> Meeting of the Building & Works Committee held on 16<sup>th</sup> November 2021.

#### Item No. 19.3 Payment of construction related to OBC Boys and Girl's hostel Pilling.

The 17<sup>th</sup> BOG, approved the recommendation made by the Finance Committee for the release of payment of piling works of the OBC Boys' and Girls' hostel on an installment basis from the available IRG Fund of the Institute due to the unavailability of funds under OH-35. The 17<sup>th</sup> BWC recommended that the payment may be released as per the terms and conditions mentioned. However, as the file is processed for payment, physical verification of the piles are required as the pilings were completed in August 2017 and further superstructure is already constructed. The matter is placed before the BWC for direction.

The committee noted and suggest puting up in the next FC/BOG to seek the advice for the payment to be decided either from IRG as approved before or from OH-35.

#### Item No. 19.4 Miscellaneous items:

With reference to the letter from the Under Secretary, MOE, dated 03/02/2022 regarding the identification of priority infrastructure to be continued/constructed for the Institute based on (i) Prof. Gandhi report and (ii) ADG report and to prepare preliminary cum detailed estimates taking help of CPWD to ascertain the financial estimates of the works. The committee noted the recommendation of the Institute Construction Committee (ICC) and suggest to submit the preliminary estimation of the priority infrastructure which is are as follows:

(i) Completion of 30 men barrack.

- Road connectivity of two lanes from the administration building to 30 men barraek.
  This road shall be 500 mm above the expected water level in the monsoon.
- (ii) Completion of type- III and type- IV quarters as per the design.
  - Soil filling in the area surrounding the above Type III and Type IV quarters. Soil filling shall extend a minimum 10 m (horizontally) all around the buildings and shall have an elevation 500 mm above the water level in monsoon. This is required to have the facility for parking and to keep the surface water away during the monsoon.
  - Road connectivity from the main gate of the eastern campus to the type-III and type-IV quarters. This road shall be 500 mm above the expected water level in the monsoon. The road shall be made along the compound wall, which will help to block the illegal drains entering the campus.
- (iii) Completion of multi-purpose auditorium/Hall.
- (iv) Completion of OBC Boys and OBC Girls hostel as per the design
- (v) To raise the road from the main gate to OBC boys Hostel via. Boys Hostel 2.
