A student will get two attempts to pass subjects once in the end semester examination and other in the supplementary examination".

The Senate was informed that Training and Placement cell of Institute has made tremendous efforts for placement of students even in COVID situation, as a result 03 Computer Science and Engineering students have got very good package in Microsoft and Intuit.
