ORDER

Imphal, the 17th March 2021

No.NITM.1(53-Estt)/Hostel/2019/(Pt.204). In pursuance of the recommendation of the Hostel Management committee, the hostels of NIT Manipur will now be opened for B.Tech final year students. The students will now have the option to enter and stay in their respective hostel under the following conditions:

- (i) The students will be permitted to enter their respective hostels only on production of COVID-19 negative test report conducted 72 hours prior to their arrival.
- (ii) Necessary arrangement is being made by the Institute to conduct RT-PCR test for COVID-19 on 5th and 6th April 2021 in coordination with the State Health Department. The venue and timing will be notified, once a confirmation is received from the State Health Department.
- (iii) Students returning on other dates will have to make their own arrangement for testing at their own cost.
- (iv) Since no insurance fee was collected from the students during registration for current semester i.e. Jan-May 2021, the students will have to bear cost of any medical expenses during their stay in hostels.
- (v) The Hostel fees will be charged on pro-rata basis w.e.f. 5th April 2021. The amount to be deposited for hostel is fixed at Rs.1458.00 for this semester.
- (vi) Students will be allowed to enter to their hostel only on production of proof of deposit of hostel fees including mess fees. The mess fees has been fixed at Rs.10,500.00 @ Rs.140 per day. The approved mess menu is also enclosed for reference. The food for hostel residents will be served in their respective room till notified otherwise.
- (vii) Students should strictly follow the SOP issued by the Institute and by MoHFW, Govt. of India and the State Government from time to time during your stay in the hostel.
- (viii) Students will be allowed entry to the hostel on production of the consent form signed by the parents/guardian.
