## Paper I (Competitive Examination):

- i) Candidates fulfilling the minimum eligibility criteria will be considered provisionally eligible to appear for the competitive written examination (**paper 1**) for 100 marks. This will be objective type examination.
- Questions for the competitive examination will be designed to test the candidate's knowledge in his/her concerned subject of specialization.
- Candidates will be recommended for appointment, in order of merit, on the basis of the performance of the candidates who qualify in both the Paper I and Paper II. Merit list will be prepared with 40% weightage for Paper I and 60% weightage for paper II.
- Success in the examination confers no right of appointment unless the Institute is satisfied after conducting enquiry that the candidate is suitable in all respects of appointment to the service/post.
