### ITEM NO. 12.18: To consider and approve the revised Object Oriented syllabus and introducing it as departmental elective.

The Senate approved the revised Object Oriented syllabus and introducing it as departmental elective of CSE department.

### ITEM NO. 12.19: Discussion on the status of some Ph.D scholars of Computer Science Engineering Department

1. **Mr. Songbiakthang Hangsing** (17403004) admitted as Ph.D scholar on 5/01/2018, failed in course work examination. He did not turn up to the institute and moreover did not inform the Supervisor since 25/05/2018.

The Senate instructed to issue a Show cause notice for his absence seeking reply within 7 days from the date of issue of the letter else his Ph.D registration may be cancelled.

- 2. The Senate approved in converting **Mr. Ginkhosiam Simte** (18403002) from Full time to Part time Ph.D scholar.
- 3. The Senate recommended for removing/replacing **Dr. Prakash Choudhary** as supervisors of M.Tech and Ph.D students of NIT Manipur notified under (Office Order No. NITM.1/(7-Estt)/Order/2018(Pf)/954 dated 19/12/2018) as he left this institute for NIT Hamirpur.
- 4. The Senate also recommended for removing **Dr. S. Birendra Singh**, former Director, NIT Manipur as the Supervisor of Mr. Angom Buboo Singh in the Department of Computer Science and Engineering Department as he has retired from NIT Manipur.

#### ITEM NO. 12.20: Discussion on course work for M.Tech to Ph.D.

The Senate advised that the Ph.D scholars who have passed M.Tech from NIT Manipur, should be made to take subjects as course works different from subjects which he/she had taken in M.Tech except those subjects which are directly related to the Ph.D topic and also the minimum time lapse between registration of the subjects in M.Tech degree and Ph.D admission is three years.

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### ITEM NO. 12.21: Discussion on detention criteria for B. Tech students

The Senate advised to follow the instructions of the present Ordinances & Regulations of the Institute.

#### ITEM NO. 12.22: Discussion on not to conduct Re-evaluation of marks

The Senate advised all the faculty members to show the answer sheets for verification to the students for every examination (within 1<sup>st</sup> week of registration for the next semester) before uploading the marks. There after no verification/evaluation will be entertained after the declaration of results.

### ITEM NO. 12.23: The External Peer Review Committee report as per the instruction of National Project Implementation Unit

The Senate noted the External Peer Review Committee's evaluative report and qualitative evaluation conducted on 13/05/2019 on the instruction of NPIU.

The Senate also instructed the Departmental Visiting Committee and External Institute Review Committee constituted and approved by 12<sup>th</sup> BoG held on 07/08/2018 to review the institute in December, 2019.

### ITEM NO. 12.24: To fix the date of 6<sup>th</sup> Convocation of NIT Manipur

The Senate approved the proposal to hold the institute's 6<sup>th</sup> Convocation on 30<sup>th</sup> September, 2019.

### ITEM NO. 12.25: To consider and approve students residing within 10 km radius to attend classes from their respective residence

The Senate approved that students residing within 10 km radius to attend classes from their residence.

#### ITEM NO. 12.26: Any other items with the permission of the chair.

1. A representation has been received from Mr. Ingudam Bidyasagar, Enrollment No. 15PCE004 requesting to conduct Comprehensive examination (2<sup>nd</sup> attempt). He had earlier appeared for the comprehensive exam (1<sup>st</sup> attempt) on 29/08/2019 where he could not clear the examination. So the student has requested to conduct the 2<sup>nd</sup> comprehensive examination at the earliest so that he may smoothly progress his Ph.D research study in the Institute.

As per the Ph.D ordinance, Clause 11.5 and 11.6, a Ph.D student if failed in comprehensive should be reported to the Senate and second comprehensive should be conducted within one to six months. In this

ller GM/ case, comprehensive exam was conducted on 29/08/2018 and failure status was not reported to the Senate earlier nor 2<sup>nd</sup> comprehensive held within 6 months.

The matter was placed and after due discussion and deliberation, the Senate approved as a special case to allow and conduct 2<sup>nd</sup> Comprehensive exam for Mr. Ingudam Bidyasagar at the earliest.

2. A representation addressing to Dean (AA) has been received from Miss. Solarica Palit who secured 8474 rank in GATE-2019. She attended CCMT counselling and opted M.Tech CSE programme, NIT Manipur as her First Choice. During verification, she mistakenly did not obtain the main verification certificate after performing all the formalities.

In view of the above, she has requested the institute to allow/permit her to admit at NIT Manipur.

After discussion and deliberation on the above, the Senate approved to admit her at NIT Manipur.

- 3. The Summer Internship ranging 4-6 weeks duration is mandatory for B.Tech students after their 6<sup>th</sup> Semester. In this connection, the Senate advised to give 2 credit points to Summer Internship accordingly and the students be instructed to give summer internship report and seminar presentation in the 7<sup>th</sup> Semester.
- 4. The Director apprised the Senate that IIEST, Shibpur, the TEQIP-III mentor of NIT Manipur is interested for collaborative work with Civil Engineering Department, NIT Manipur in the area of Seismic studies, Spring shed management, Rain water harvesting, Geo-informatics survey, Environmental pollution, Ground water and open cast mining.

The meeting ended with a vote of thanks to the Chair.
